- 1) Each waste stream will be determined on a case-by-case basis by MAWSA following review of analytical results provided by the waste hauler prior to acceptance.
- 2) TSS Surcharge is as follows:

Greater than 2% up to and including 4% - Additional 25% of Base Fee Greater than 4% up to and including 5% - Additional 50% of Base Fee Greater than 5% - case-by-case basis

3) COD Surcharge is as follows:

Greater than 1,000 mg/L up to and including 3,000 mg/L - Additional 10% of Base Fee Greater than 3,000 mg/L up to and including 6,000 mg/L - Additional 25% of Base Fee Greater than 6,000 mg/L up to and including 10,000 mg/L - Additional 40% of Base Fee Greater than 10,000 mg/L - case-by-case basis

All charges will be invoiced to the hauler at the end of every billing cycle. Each unique load will be tested and categorized according to its TSS and COD as determined by the sample analysis taken at the facility. Delinquent Hauled Waste Invoices: A 5% penalty will be applied after 30-days of the invoice date.

Any manifest submitted incomplete will be charged a \$25.00 penalty for non-compliance
